Meeting began with self introductions by the attendees.

Dennis Hall of NOAA-CSC briefed the committee on CSC activities and FY-2010 priorities (copy of presentation outline included) followed by Q&A. Discussion on new CGSC re-compete. There will not be small business set aside.

Mike Aslaksen of NOAA-NGS briefed the committee on ARRA funding received, 40 M mostly going towards hydrographic surveys and 2.2 M for Great Lakes shoreline using Border Security/DHS imagery. All 6 shoreline prime contractors received some work from this ARRA project. The President's budget has 2.4 M for this program. The image Services contract will be out for re-compete in FY 2010.

Mike Espey of NOAA-NGS briefed the committee on the ARRA project in Louisiana, flown by NOAA and data extraction performed by the contractor (Aero-Metric). A successful demonstration that NOAA acquisition followed by contractor extraction services met the project schedule and requirements for deliverables.

Chris Parrish of NOAA-NGS informed the committee that a new LiDAR SOW related to airport obstruction surveys is being posted on their website.

General Q&A by committee members then followed for the remainder of the meeting.
